On visiting the BARTECH, principal Mrs. Pearlette Hannaway was able to lead the contingent to experience first-hand programmes being conducted at the institute.

A highlight of the Ambassador's tour was meeting former Deputy Prime Minister, Area representative and Minister of Foreign Affairs Sir Louis Straker. Sir Louis Straker was able to share his wealth of experience and knowledge with the new Ambassador even though he is no longer in active politics and welcomed him into St. Vincent and the Grenadines, more so into Central Leeward.

Minister Brewster took the opportunity to show-off site and sounds of his constituency to the Ambassador, visiting the Walliabou Heritage Park, Pirates of the Caribbean Site, Peter's Hope development, Layou Waterfront and the Buccament Bay beach area.
